Report:

Narrative - On Tuesday, August 21, 2012, Detectives Buonaiuto and Brock interviewed Synet, Inc. President, Stephen P. Beauvais provided the following information.

Beauvais was shown a copy of a Synet Change Proposal C11011 CP-01 and asked if he could explain the purpose of the documents.

Beauvais explained that the document is a Change Proposal, not a Change Order. He described it as being associated to a job that Synet had first proposed to Tazza Cafe'. When it was pointed out to Beauvais that the C11011 number associated this Change Proposal to the 38 Studios job, not the Tazza job, Beauvais stated that it was probably done accidentally by someone in the company using a 38 Studios document to create a new Tazza document, but not changing over all of the numbers.

When asked by Detectives if Synet charged the cost of work done at Tazza to the 38 Studios job, Beauvais stated that the company had not.

Beauvais stated that the actual work performed at Tazza by Synet did not amount to the initial \$20,077.48 quote that Synet was initially preparing. Beauvais stated that initially Synet quoted an entire Audio Visual job for Tazza, which Beauvais stated resulted in the "Cookie Cutter" price in excess of \$20,000.00. Ultimately, Synet installed a speaker system and a Closed Circuit TV system at Tazza. Beauvais estimated it cost to Tazza at about \$4000-\$5000.

Beauvais was shown a copy of the Synet budget report for the 38 Studios job that was provided Detectives by Michael Rossi. Beauvais reviewed the document, but could not explain why there was a Tazza line item valued at \$25,000.00 in the expense column. Beauvais stated that Synet Business Development Agent Dana Caggiano would have prepared the 38 Studios budget report.

Beauvais stated that today was the first time he saw a 38 Studios job budget report with a Tazza line item of

\$25,000.00 listed on it. Beauvais denied seeing it when Synet first started the 38 Studios job and denied having a prior conversation with Caggiano about it.

Beauvais was unable to provide detectives with a Tazza budget report.

Beauvais stated that he was never approached by anyone telling him that he had to do work for Michael Corso or Tazza if he wanted to get the job at 38 Studios.
