1. Someone breaks into a motor home and steals something.

3. A hostage situation.

4. Something is stolen from inside an unlocked car.

5. Someone steals a farm tractor.

6. Someone kills a robber during a bank robbery.

7. Someone breaks into an unoccupied cabin and takes something.

8. A person drives away from a self service gas station without paying.

9. Someone hits someone else with a baseball bat.

10. Someone steals a golf cart.

11. Someone forces a 14 year old girl have sex with them.

12. Paying a basketball player to throw a game.

13. Something is stolen from inside a locked car.

14. How many Incidents? Six units of a mini-storage facility are burglarized.

15. How many incidents? During a two-man robbery, one robber goes into the other room rapes and kills a woman.

26. Someone steals a car from an unlocked, but closed, private garage.

27. Someone is arrested for accessory to murder.

28. An 18 year-old uses a 21-year old friend's license to buy beer.

29. A son borrows his parents' vehicle for a few days. He then gives the vehicle to his girlfriend. The parents inquire about the car, and the son states it was stolen. The parents make a stolen auto report, but the evidence later shows that the girlfriend has the car. Is this a Motor Vehicle Theft?
